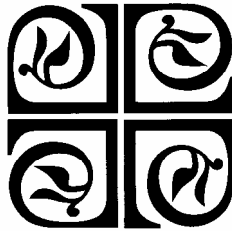



Please take an empty glass from the tray held by the acolyte. The bread will be placed in your hand. After receiving the bread, please hold up the glass to easily facilitate the pouring of wine. Place the used glass in the tray held by the acolyte near the outside aisle. Reception of Holy Communion under one kind (bread or wine) is valid communion for those who must avoid either for health reasons. Children not yet communing may come forward for a blessing.



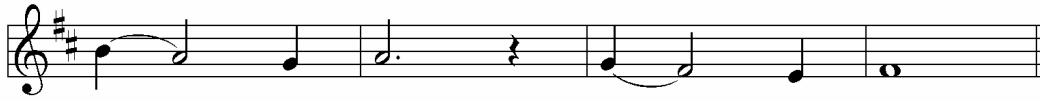
